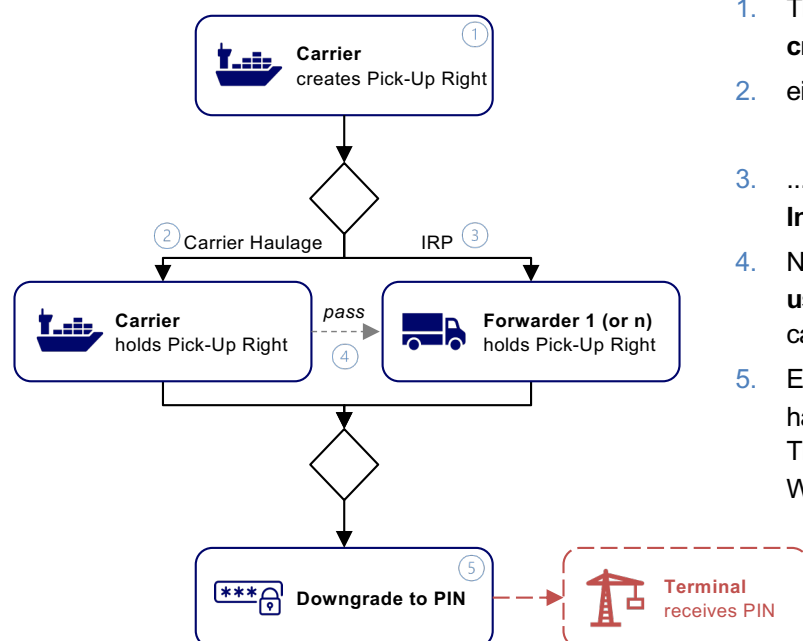


Overview of the standard process for carriers up to terminal go-live of SROs



Overview of the standard process

1. The standard process for carriers starts with the **creation** of the Pick-Up Right and assigns it...
2. either to itself via **Carrier's Haulage**...
or
3. ... via creating the Pick-Up Right and assigning it to the **Initial Release Party (IRP)**, e.g. a forwarder.
4. Nevertheless, the Pick-Up Right can be **handled as usual**, i.e. it can be passed, returned, revoked and cancelled. Used example: "pass".
5. Eventually, anyone of the current Pick-Up Right holders has to conduct the function "**Downgrade to PIN**". Thereby, the conducting entity receives the PIN via Web-UI and email.

Important note

A COREOR with the PIN is only sent to the terminal after a Downgrade to PIN has been performed!
